С		42127-1 Blue	1-3/8	Kaleidoscope blocks (16) B pieces using provided template. Star blocks (8) A, (8) B, (8) C and (8) D pieces using provided templates. (1) 3" x 42". Subcut (4) 3" x 3" squares.

Constructing Star Blocks

1. Block Center. Sew one E and one G piece to the opposite sides of one H piece to make a subunit. Repeat to make a total of 4 subunits.



2. Sew 2 subunits to the opposite sides of (1) $3" \times 3"$ B square to make a row.



Sew (2) $3" \times 3"$ B squares to the opposite of 1 subunit made in step 1 to make a row. Repeat to make two identical rows.



3. Sew rows together to complete block center.





SQ TO 8"

4. Sew one C band one D piece to the opposite sides of one H piece to make a row.



Repeat to make two rows, and add to the right and left sides of block center.



Sew one A and one B pieces to the opposite sides of one H piece to make a row.



Repeat to make two rows, and add to the top and bottom of block center to complete 1 block.

5. Repeat to make a total number of blocks in the following colorways:



Constructing Kaleidoscope Blocks




Refer to block schematic diagram and quilt center diagram for fabric placement, make a total of 17 kaleidoscope blocks. Sq to 13"

Designer's suggestion: The supporting kaleidoscope blocks do not have a systematic distribution of the sku placement from block to block, so they might be difficult make ahead of time. The easiest way to assembly the quilt center would be to make the star blocks first, and lay them out. Refer to the quilt center diagram to make the kaleidoscope blocks one at a time and lay them out by the star blocks before sewing them into rows and then quilt center.



Quilt Center Assembly

1. Pieced Rows. Arrange and sew 5 pieced blocks into (7) pieced rows.



2. Sew pieced rows together to complete quilt center. Reference diagram on the next page.



Quilt Top Assembly

3. Outer border. Sew (2) 3" x 88" F strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) 3" x 68" F strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.





Quilting Instructions


With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.

Key Block (14/50 actual size)






