

HALF LOG CABIN

QUILT SIZE IS APPROXIMATELY 56.5 x 70.5

BLOCKS SET IS ON-POINT 4 x 5

BLOCK SIZE 10 INCHES (10.5 INCHES WITH SEAM ALLOWANCES)



QUILT NOTES:

1. You can change the size of this quilt by adding blocks or borders, or changing the size of the center square and strips. Using a 3.5 inch center square and 2 inch strips would give you a 7.5 inch finished block (8 inches with seam allowances).
2. Use a variety of different purple, fuchsia, and green fabrics.

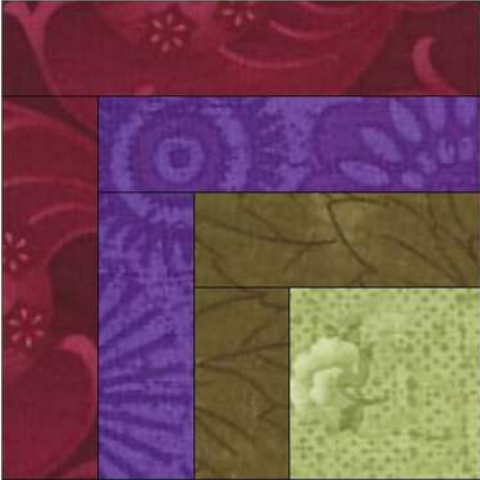
PIECING BLOCKS – MAKE 32

Center squares are cut 4.5 inches

Logs are cut 2.5 inches

I chain pieced my blocks and trim the strip I'm adding with scissors.

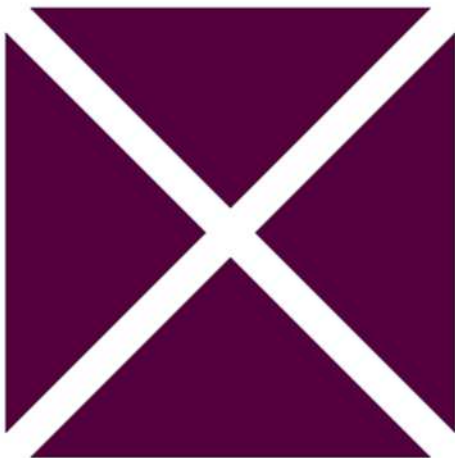
Starting with the center, border it on two sides using the same fabric. Add next two rounds for a total of three.



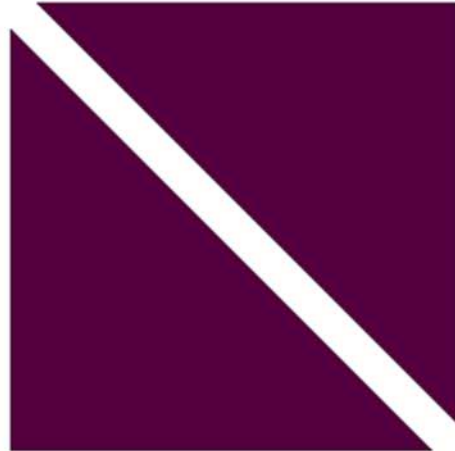
SETTING TRIANGLES

I cut my triangles with a setting triangle ruler but the cutting instructions are below.

From a 15.5 inch square, you will get 4 triangles when you cut the square from corner to corner twice.



Cut two 8 inch squares from corner to corner for your corner triangles.



ASSEMBLE TOP

Using the diagram on page one of these instructions, assemble blocks into rows and sew together.

If you are unfamiliar with how to assemble an on-point setting, please refer to a basic quilting book.

HALF LOG CABIN VARIATION

Quilt size with borders is approximately 65 x 79

Assemble quilt as show above and add borders.

Inner border is cut 2 inches

Outer border is cut 3.5 inches
