


(Please note: Follow the diagram shown for fabric choices. For A and C units, multiple fabrics are shown. Decide how many fabrics you wish to include, then adjust cutting for A and C units accordingly.)



Cut Square Once Diagonally










C:	Cut (24) 1" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square. Cut (24) 1 ½" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.	Cut (24) 2" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.
D:	Cut (12) 1" $\times$ 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.	Cut (12) 1 ¼" x 2" rectangles.	Cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.	Cut (12) 2" x 3 ½" rectangles.
E:	Cut (4) ¾" squares.	Cut (4) %" squares.	Cut (4) 1" squares.	Cut (4) 1 1/4" squares.
F:	Cut (1) 1" square.	Cut (1) 1 1/4" square.	Cut (1) 1 ½" square.	Cut (1) 2" square.
G:	Cut (8) 3/4" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.	Cut (8) %" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.	Cut (8) 1" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.	Cut (8) 1 1/4" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.
H:	Cut (4) <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 1" rectangles.	Cut (4) %" x 1 ¼" rectangles.	Cut (4) 1" $\times$ 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.	Cut (4) 1¼" x 2" rectangles.


### ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Begin HST unit assembly using (36) A triangles and (36) B triangles. Place triangles right sides together and edges aligned.
- 2. Sew the longest edges of the triangles together using a 1/4" seam. Press toward the darkest triangle fabric.
- 3. Repeat to create (36) HST units using A and B triangles. Trim HST units using the following guide:
  - a. 4" Block: 1" x 1" unfinished (½" x ½" finished)
  - b. 6" Block: 11/4" x 11/4" unfinished (3/4" x 3/4" finished)
  - c. 8" Block: 11/2" x 11/2" unfinished (1" x 1" finished)
  - d. 12" Block: 2" x 2" unfinished (1 1/2" x 1 1/2" finished)






















- a. 4" Block: 1" x 1 1/2" unfinished (1/2" x 1" finished)
- b. 6" Block: 11/4" x 2" unfinished (3/4" x 11/2" finished)
- c. 8" Block: 11/2" x 21/2" unfinished (1" x 2" finished)
- d. 12" Block: 2" x 3 1/2" unfinished (1 1/2" x 3" finished)



- a. 4" Block: 3/4" x 1" unfinished (1/4" x 1/2" finished)
- b. 6" Block: 1/8" x 1 1/4" unfinished (3/8" x 3/4" finished)
- c. 8" Block: 1"  $\times$  1 ½" unfinished (½"  $\times$  1" finished)
- d. 12" Block: 1 1/4" x 2" unfinished (3/4" x 1 1/2" finished)



Create (4) Small Flying Geese Units

11. Complete the center star using (4) small flying geese units, (4) E squares and (1) F square. Press seams open to reduce bulk.













Create (36) Total HST Units


### ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 12. Use the following guide for completed center star measurements for each block size:
  - a. 4" Block: 11/2" x 11/2" unfinished (1" x 1" finished)
  - b. 6" Block: 2" x 2" unfinished (1 1/2" x 1 1/2" finished)
  - c. 8" Block: 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished (2" x 2" finished)
  - d. 12" Block: 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" unfinished (3" x 3" finished)



13. Complete block assembly using the center star, (12) large flying geese, (36) HST units and the block's center star. Diagrams show accurate HST and flying geese orientation. Alternate the direction in which you press the seams in each row or press open. Diagrams show the block in all stages of assembly.





- 14. Trim block using the guide listed below:
  - a. 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished (4" x 4" finished)
  - b. 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished (6" x 6" finished)
  - c. 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished (8" x 8" finished)
  - d. 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished (12" x 12" finished)
