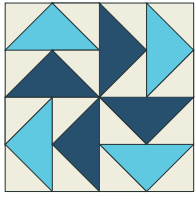

	C	Cut (1) 3" x 3"	Cut (1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"	Cut (1) 6" x 6"	Cut (1) 7 1/2" x 7 1/2"

CREATE FLYING GEESSE UNITS - 4 AT A TIME METHOD

1. Draw a line through **(4) fabric A** squares.
2. Place **(2) fabric A** RST on **(1) fabric B** in opposite corners, as shown in **Figure 1**.
3. Sew 1/4" away on either side of the drawn line.
4. Cut on the line & press toward **fabric A** to yield 2 units as shown in **Figure 2**.
5. Place **(1) fabric A** RST on **each of the two units created in step 4**, as shown in **Figure 3**. (you should have 2 units)
6. Sew 1/4" away on either side of the drawn line, then cut on the line & press toward **fabric B** to yield **4 Flying Geese A** units, as shown in **Figure 4**.
7. Repeat steps 1-6 with **fabric A** and **fabric C** to create **4 Flying Geese 'B'** units. (Use the figures to the right, just replace 'fabric B' with 'fabric C').
8. Trim the **(8) Flying Geese** (4 of Flying Geese A, 4 of Flying Geese B) units to the following measurements:
 - 3" Finished: 2" x 1 1/4"
 - 6" Finished: 3 1/2" x 2"
 - 9" Finished: 5" x 2 3/4"
 - 12" Finished: 6 1/2" x 3 1/2"

This sheet walks you through the 4-at-a-time method for Flying Geese. If this isn't your preferred method, go to page 2 for the Traditional Method!

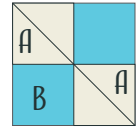

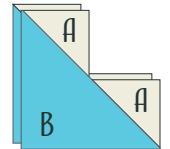

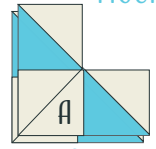

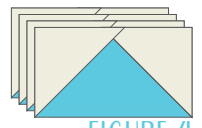

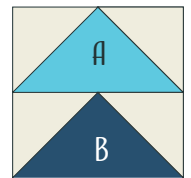

ASSEMBLE THE 4 BLOCKS

1. Sew **Flying Geese A** and **Flying Geese B** together as shown in **Figure 5**.
2. Press seam towards Flying Geese A
3. Trim the **(4) Blocks** to the following measurements:
 - 3" Finished: 2" x 2"
 - 6" Finished: 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
 - 9" Finished: 5" x 5"
 - 12" Finished: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

SEW THE BLOCK TOGETHER

1. Sew the **4 blocks together** in a 4-patch configuration, as shown in **Figure 6**.
2. Press seam towards Flying Geese A
3. Trim the **(4) Blocks** to the following measurements:
 - 3" Finished: 1 1/4" x 2"
 - 6" Finished: 2" x 3 1/2"
 - 9" Finished: 2 3/4" x 5"
 - 12" Finished: 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"

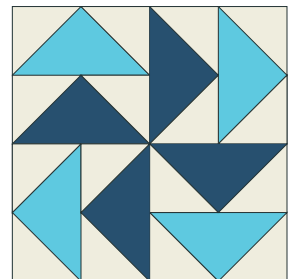
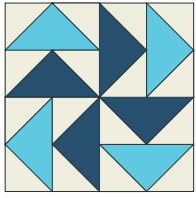

CREATE FLYING GEESSE UNITS - TRADITIONAL METHOD

1. Draw a line from corner to corner through **(16) fabric A** squares.
2. Place **(1) fabric A** square RST on the right side of **(1) fabric B** rectangle with the line going from the top middle of the fabric B rectangle to the lower right corner of the fabric B rectangle, as illustrated in **Figure 1**.
3. Sew on the drawn line, trim ¼" away, then press the **seam towards fabric B**.
4. Place **(1) fabric A** square RST on the left side of the **piece created in the steps above**, ensuring the line is going from the top middle of the fabric B rectangle to the lower left corner of the fabric B rectangle, as illustrated in **Figure 2**.
5. Sew on the drawn line, trim ¼" away, then press the **seam towards fabric B**.
6. Repeat **steps 1-5** until you have **(4) Flying Geese A** units, and **(4) Flying Geese B** units, as illustrated in **Figure 2**.
7. Trim the **(8) Flying Geese** (4 of Flying Geese A, 4 of Flying Geese B) units to the following measurements:

3" Finished: 1¼" x 2"
 6" Finished: 2" x 3½"
 9" Finished: 2¾" x 5"
 12" Finished: 3½" x 6½"

This method uses the traditional stitch & flip method for flying geese!

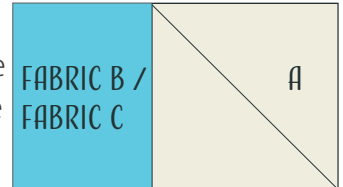

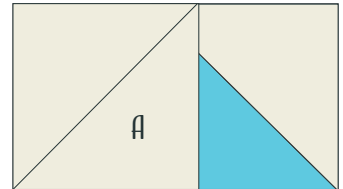

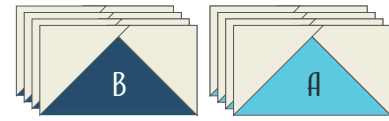

ASSEMBLE THE 4 BLOCKS

1. Sew **Flying Geese A** and **Flying Geese B** together as shown in **Figure 4**.
2. Press seam towards Flying Geese A
3. Trim the **(4) Blocks** to the following measurements:
 - 3" Finished: 2" x 2"
 - 6" Finished: 3½" x 3½"
 - 9" Finished: 5" x 5"
 - 12" Finished: 6½" x 6½"

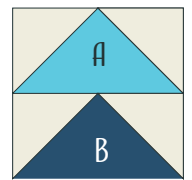

SEW THE BLOCK TOGETHER

1. Sew the **4 blocks together** in a 4-patch configuration, as shown in **Figure 5**.
2. Press seam towards Flying Geese A
3. Trim the **(4) Blocks** to the following measurements:
 - 3" Finished: 1¼" x 2"
 - 6" Finished: 2" x 3½"
 - 9" Finished: 2¾" x 5"
 - 12" Finished: 3½" x 6½"

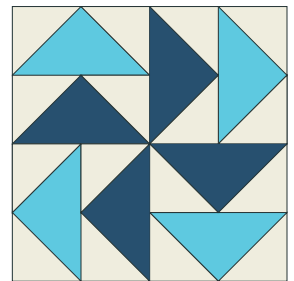
