PROJECT: Rail Fence Block

FINISHED BLOCK: 12" square

MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

□ 1— $2\frac{1}{2}$ ×30" strip *each* of solid green, pink, and teal


ASSEMBLE BLOCK


Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.


Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

- 1. Referring to Diagram 1 and aligning long edges, sew together solid 2½×30" strips to make a strip set. Press seams in one direction. The strip set should be 6½×30" including seam allowances.
- **2.** Cut strip set into four $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (Diagram 2).
- **3.** Referring to **Diagram 3** for color placement, sew together squares in pairs. Press seams open. Join pairs to make a Rail Fence block. Press seam in one direction. The block should be 12½" square including seam allowances.
