

Triangles and Squares Quilt Pattern



This quilt is perfect for quilters who enjoy working with both structured geometry and open-ended creativity. The combination of simple shapes-squares, half-square triangles, and triangle-in-a-square blocks-offers a great opportunity to explore color play and contrast. Whether you're a beginner looking for a manageable layout or an experienced quilter hoping to showcase your fabric stash, this pattern provides a flexible framework with stunning visual results.

Quilt size: 54" x 66"

Block size: 6" finished (6.5" with seam allowances)

Blocks: Set 9 blocks across and 11 blocks down

Block Construction:

- 40 Half Square Triangles - 6.5" unfinished
- 10 Triangle in a Square blocks - 6.5" unfinished
- 49 Print Squares - 6.5" x 6.5"

Assembly:

Layout the blocks 9 across and 11 down using the reference image above. Sew rows, then join them to complete the top.

Fabric Requirements:

- 2 yards light background fabric
- 2 yards blue (triangle blocks and binding)
- 2.25 yards printed fabric

Notes:

Triangle in a Square blocks can be made with Tri-Recs rulers.

Half Square Triangles can be made using any preferred method or with an AccuQuilt GO.

Adjust yardage based on your cutting method.

This quilt is a great way to explore basic geometry with a bold and modern twist.
