

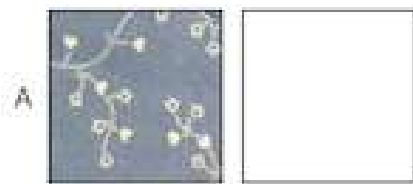
Finished block measures  
10 in. high and 10 in. wide  
Fabric strips are 42 in. long

Use 2 different fabrics for each piece  
as indicated for front and back  
throughout.

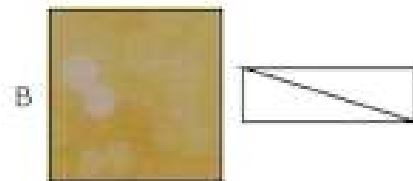
Layer front and back fabrics, wrong  
sides facing each other, to ensure  
you get mirrored pieces when you  
cut them out.

Cut 1 piece of batting for each front  
piece in the block, exactly the same  
size as indicated.

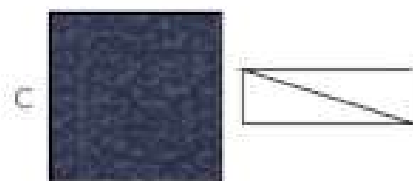
When piecing this block, start from  
the center and work your way  
around log cabin style or you can  
follow the lettering and build it  
courthouse steps style. You actually  
have a choice!



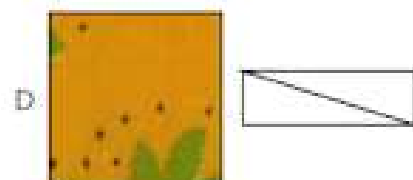
Cut 1 - 3 5/8 in. wide strip  
Cut 1 square



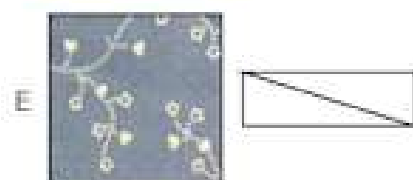
Cut 1 - 1 5/8 in. wide strip

Cut the rectangle in half to make 2 triangles



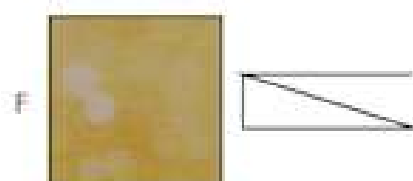
Cut 1 - 1 5/8 in. wide strip

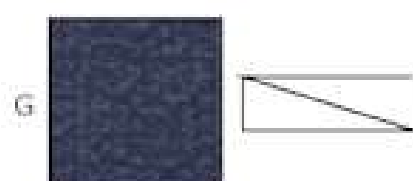
Cut 1 - 1 7/8 in. wide strip

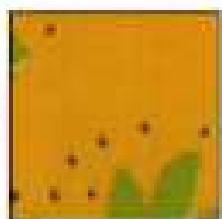

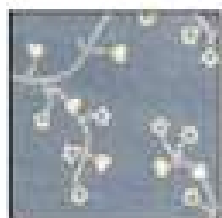

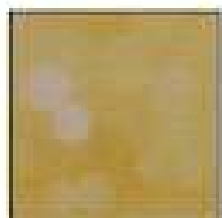
