Chevron Bag Crochet Pattern

Skill Level

Easy

Size

Bag measures approximately 16 inches wide and 16 inches tall. The handle measures around 21 inches after being attached.

Materials

Yarn

- · Hooks US 7 (4.50 mm)
- · Stitch Markers 4
- Scissors
- · Yarn needle
- · Buttons 4 (optional)

Notes

This pattern uses US terminology.

- · Ch 3 at beginning of the round counts as stitch.
- \cdot The last corner on each round is done with (ch 1, sc) instead of ch 2.

Abbreviations

beg - beginning

ch - chain

st - stitch

sk - skip

sp - space

sl st - slip stitch

nxt - next

sc - single crochet

dc - double crochet

dc2tog - double crochet 2 stitches together

Instructions: The Base

Ch 5, join with sl st to form a ring. OR use the magic ring.

Round 1: Using color A - Ch 3, working into the ring - 3dc, (ch 2, 4dc) 3 times, ending with ch 1, sc into 3rd ch of beg ch. (16 dc, 4 corner spaces)

Round 2: Ch 3, dc into sp below sc, * dc in each st across, in nxt ch-2 sp work (2dc, ch 2, 2dc), rep from * 3 times

Chevron Bag Crochet Pattern

ending with 2 dc in last sp, ch 1, sc into 3rd ch of beg ch. (32 dc)

Rounds 3 to 9: Rep Round 2. In each round you will be increasing by 16 stitches.

The Sides

Round 10: Pinch the center of each side to form an additional 'corner'. Count stitches and place markers to divide each side evenly. Example: 36 sts per side -> place marker between 18th and 19th dc.

Ch 3, dc in sp below sc, *dc in next 15 sts, dc2tog, sk 2 sts, dc2tog, dc in next 15 sts, (2dc, ch 2, 2dc) in corner*, rep from * 3 times. End with 2dc in last sp, ch1, sc into 3rd ch of beg ch.

Rounds 11 to 16: Using color B, repeat Round 10.

Rounds 17 to 22: Using color C, repeat Round 10.

Round 23: Ch 1, sc in each st around, 3 sc in each corner ch-2 sp. Fasten off and weave in all ends.

The Handles

Row 1: Using color A, ch 91, sk 1, sc in each st (90 sc). Fasten off.

Row 2: With color C, attach yarn with sl st, ch 1, sc across. Fasten off.

Row 3: With color B, repeat Row 2. Fasten off.

Attach handles through corner spaces, fold 1 inch, and stitch. Repeat for second handle.

Optional Embellishments

Sew decorative buttons onto the bag's top edge. Try Tunisian crochet for a new handle style next time!
