

Incredible Flower Square Pattern for Afghan

If you're looking for a flower square that is both stunning and intricate, the Incredible Flower Square Pattern is a must-try. It features beautiful layering with vibrant color changes and a structured square finish that's ideal for afghans, throws, bags, or even decorative pillows.

Each square measures approximately $19 \times 19 \text{ cm}$ (7.4 x 7.4 inches) and uses six different yarn colors to bring a garden-inspired texture to life.

Materials

Yarn:

- Color A
- Color B
- Color C
- Color D
- Color E
- Color F

Crochet Hook: 2.5 mm

Finished Size: 19 x 19 cm / 7.4 x 7.4 inches

Crochet Stitches Used (US Terms)

- Chain
- Slip Stitch
- Single Crochet
- Half Double Crochet
- Double Crochet
- Treble Crochet

Pattern Instructions (written in full)

Round 1 – Using Color A

- Begin with a magic ring.
- Work 3 chains (this counts as your first double crochet).
- Make 15 double crochets into the magic ring.
- Pull the ring tight to close the center.
- Join to the top of the beginning chain with a slip stitch.

Round 2 – Using Color B

- Join yarn with a slip knot.
- Make 1 chain.
- Work 1 single crochet in each of the 15 stitches around.
- Join to the first single crochet with a slip stitch.

Round 3 - Still with Color B

- Make 2 chains.
- Skip 1 stitch, and work 1 double crochet halfway (do not finish the stitch).
- In the next stitch, make another double crochet halfway, then yarn over and pull through all loops to close both together.
- Make 3 chains.

- In the same stitch, work 1 double crochet halfway.
- Skip 1 stitch, make another double crochet halfway, then pull through to join both stitches together.
- Make 3 chains.
- Repeat this petal structure all around.
- Join with a slip stitch, then make 3 chains to prepare for the next round.

Final Thoughts

This gorgeous floral square is perfect for creating a full-size afghan, a small baby blanket, or even for joining into larger projects like wall hangings and cushion covers. You can play with soft pastels, bold brights, or muted tones to make it your own.
