

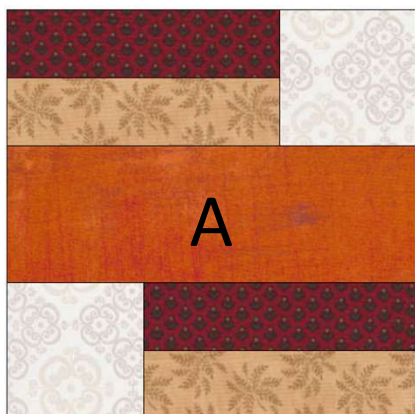

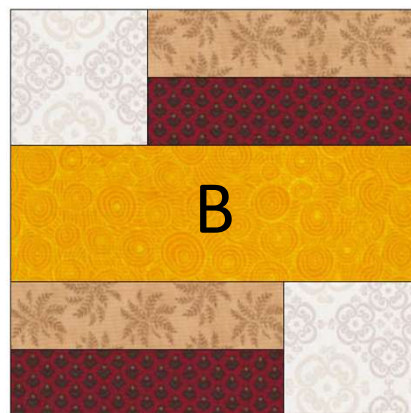

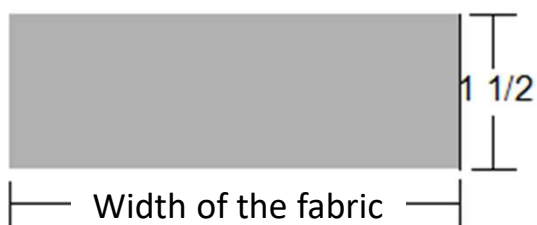

Cutting Diagrams



1 strip

- Cut a strip from selvage to selvage.
- Then cut it in half — you'll have two strips of each color.

Patch Count



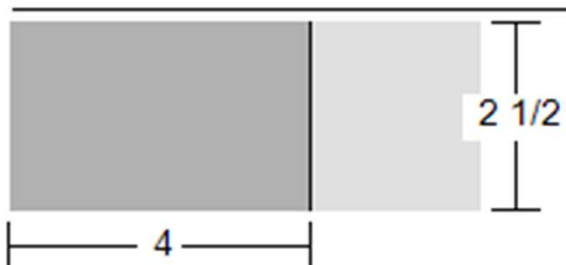

Unit A (Make 2 units)

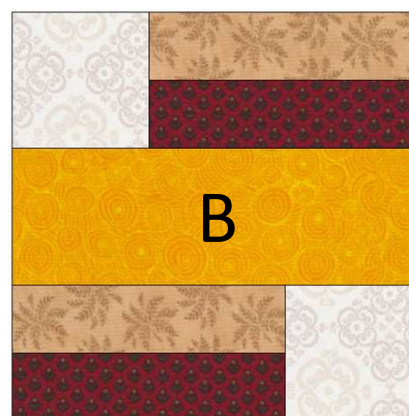
1. Sew together two (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, right sides facing. Press the seam allowance toward the red fabric.
2. Sub cut the strip set into four (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide sections.
3. Following the diagram, sew a square to one end of each strip section.
4. Join the completed strip set to a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ $2\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to finish the unit. press all seams upward.

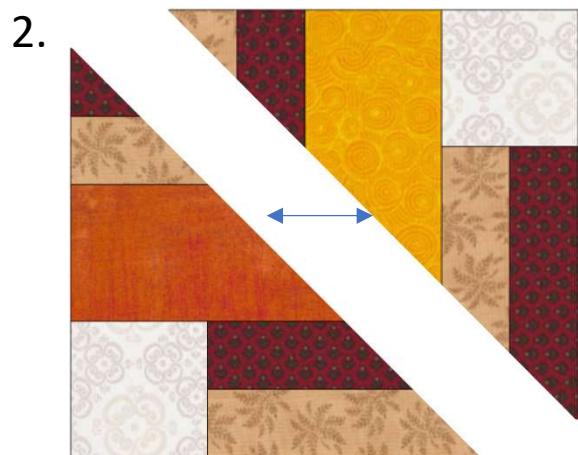
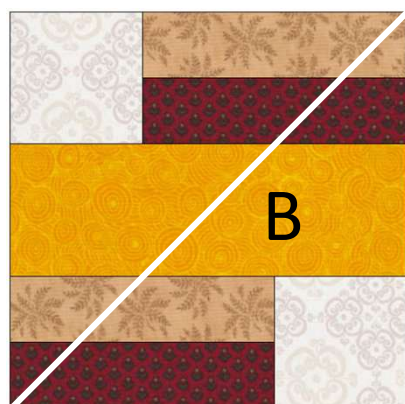
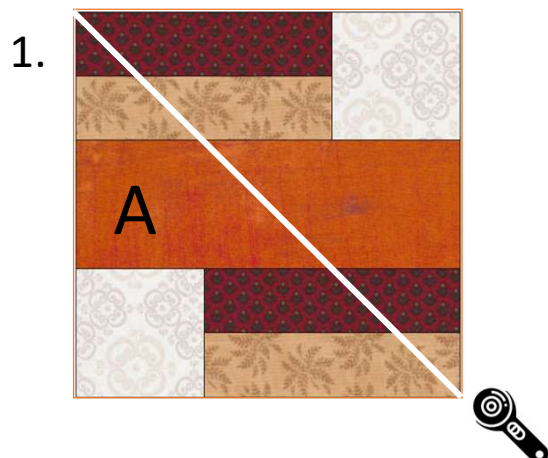




Unit B (Make 2 units)

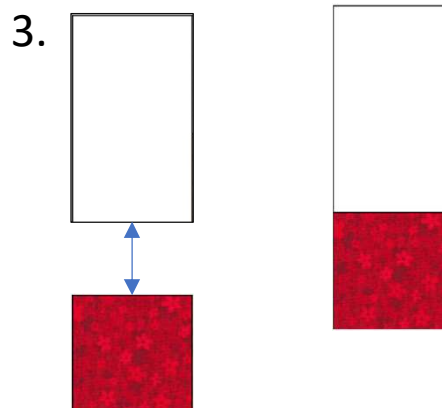
1. Sew together two (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, right sides facing. Press the seam allowance toward the tan fabric.
2. Sub cut the strip set into four (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide sections.
3. Following the diagram, sew a square to one end of each strip section.
4. Join the completed strip set to a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ $2\frac{1}{2}$ " piece to finish the unit. Press all seams downward. (opposite of Unit A)





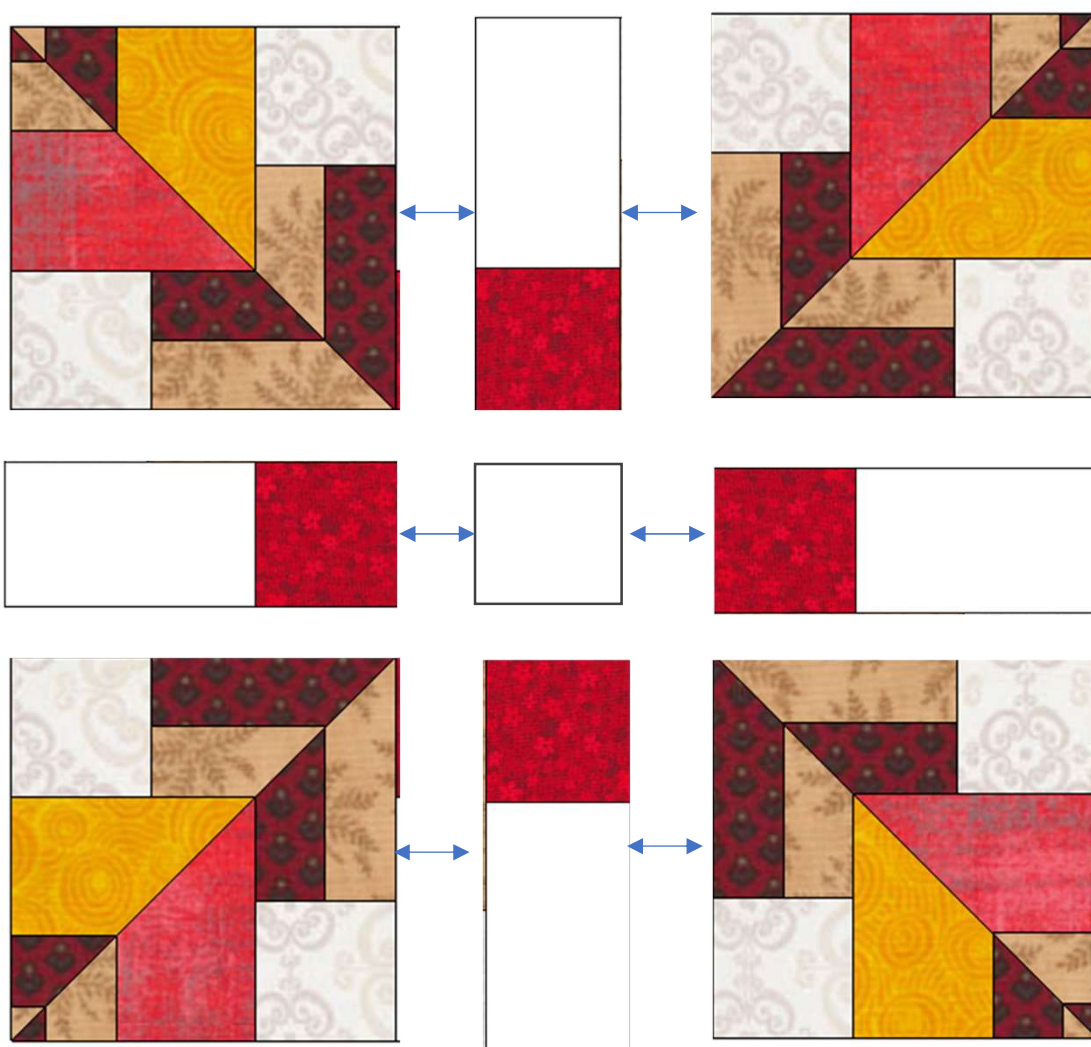
Instructions

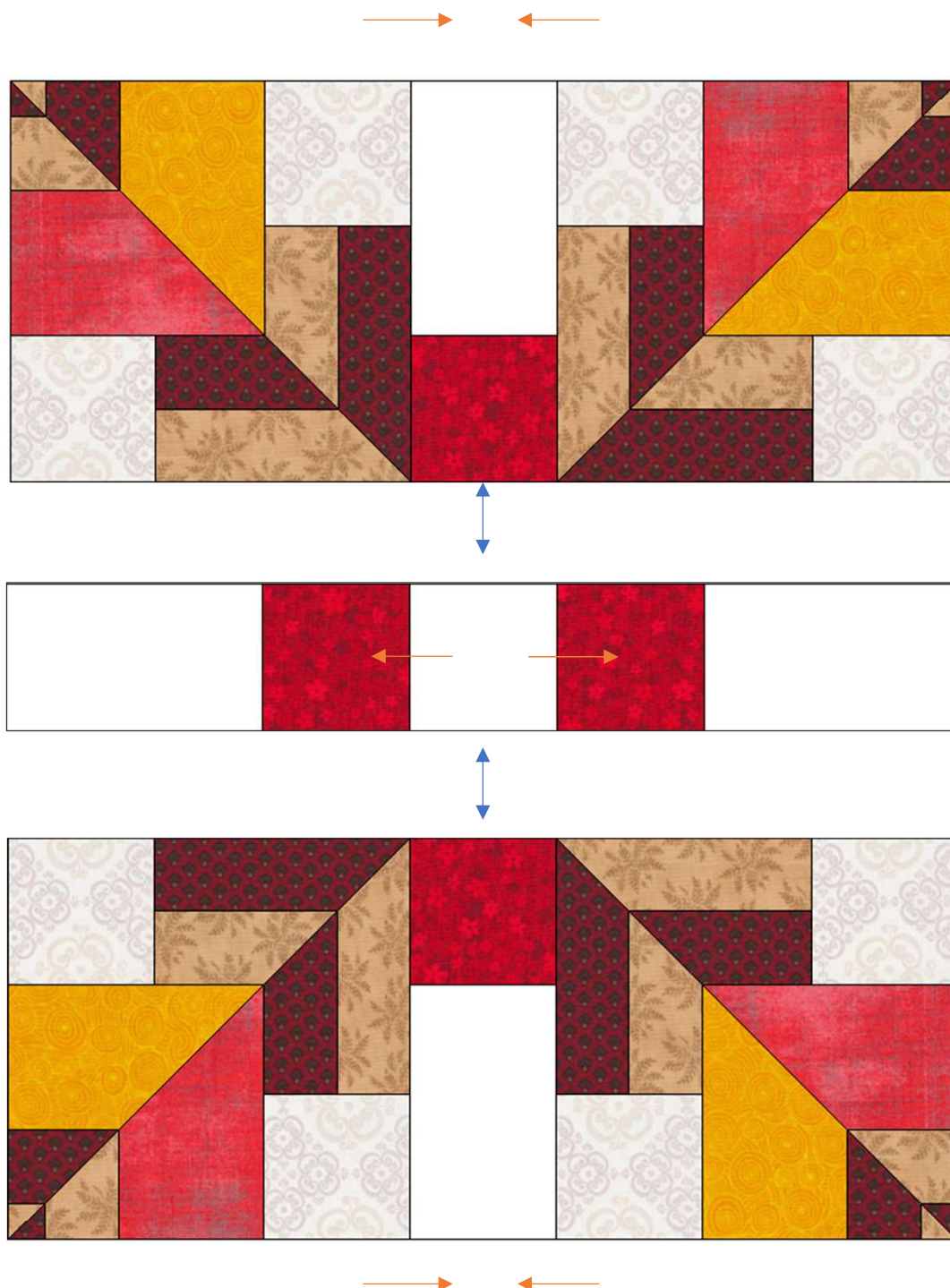
1. Cut each unit diagonally as shown in the diagram.
2. Arrange the triangles in alternating directions and sew them back together. Trim to 6" square. Make 4 units
3. Join the white and red pieces to make the center strip. You'll need 4 units per block



Instructions (Cont.)

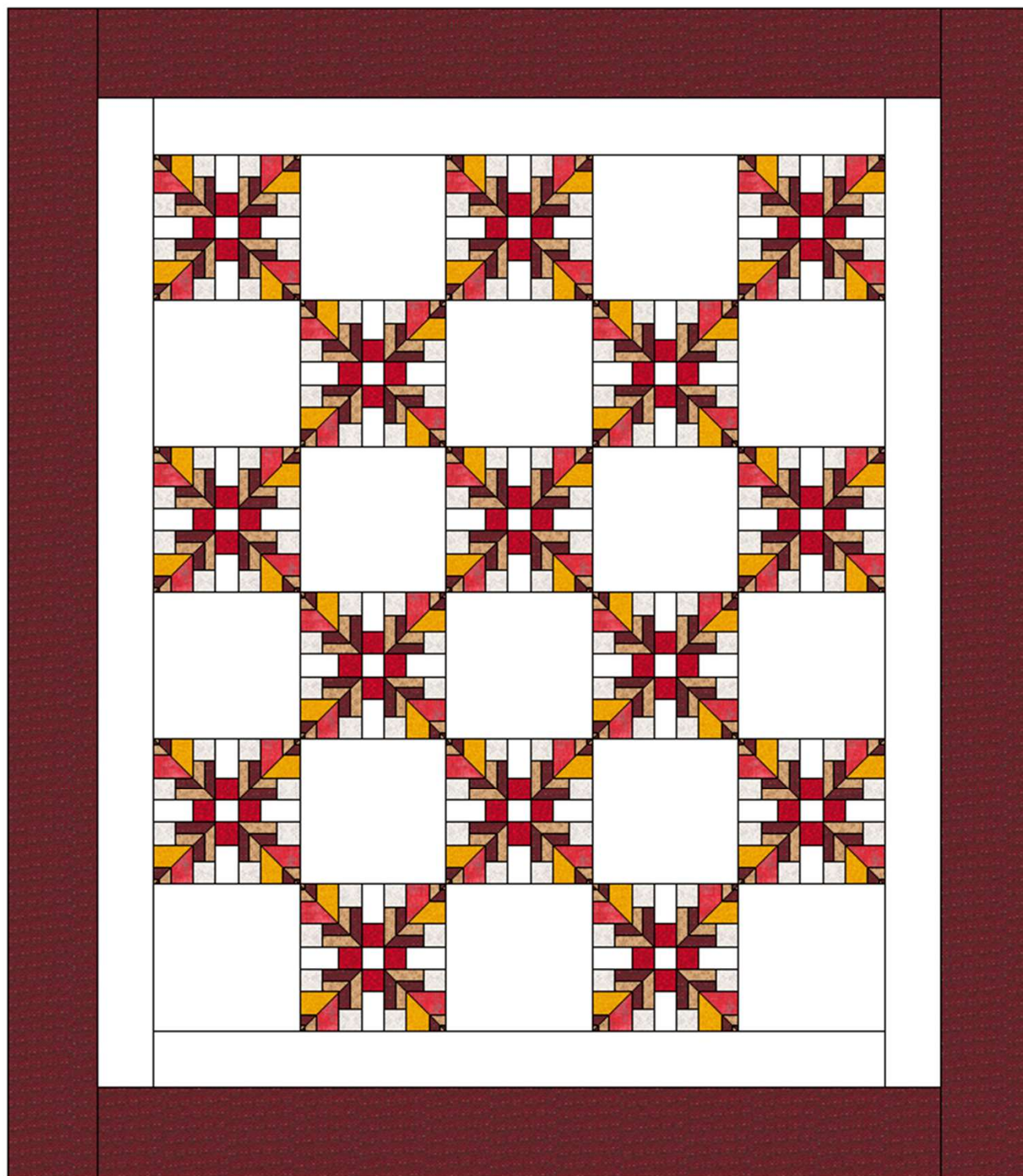
4. Following the diagram, join the units into three rows, pressing the seams in opposite directions for each row.
5. Sew the rows together to complete the block.





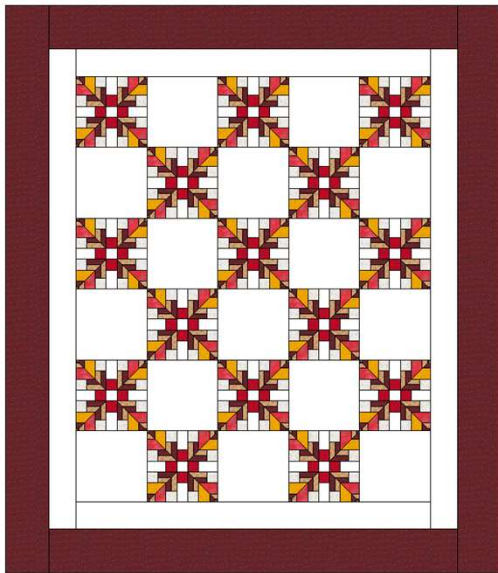
← = Seam direction

This layout uses 15 blocks and 15 background squares (Cut $13\frac{1}{2}'' \times 13\frac{1}{2}''$)

Inner Border:

(2) strips — $65\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$

(2) strips — $88'' \times 5\frac{1}{2}''$

Outer Border:

(2) strips — $75\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$

(2) strips — $104\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$
