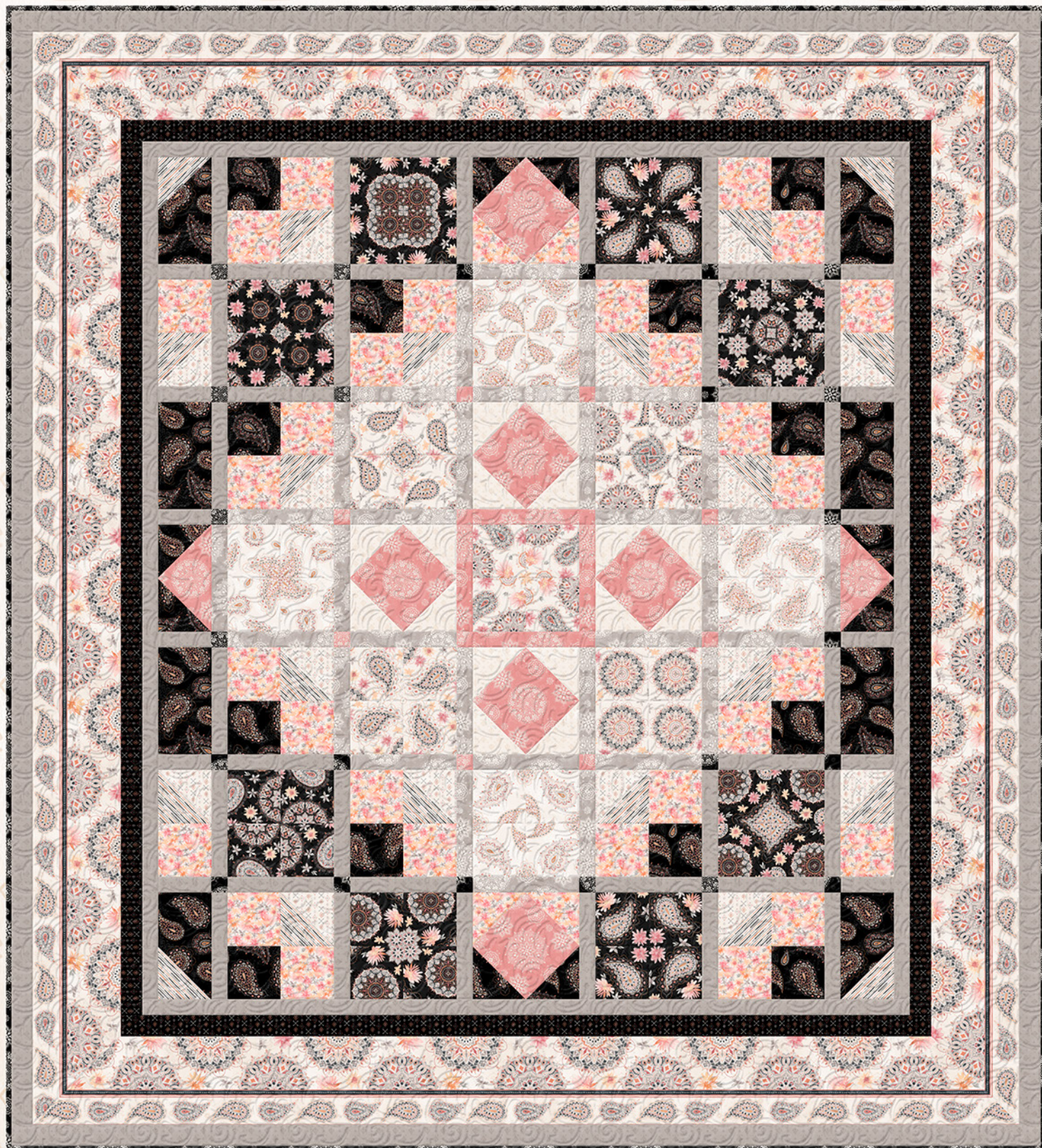

King/Queen Quilt: 96 1/2" x 106 1/2"



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Paisley Place

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 107" and (2) 8-3/4" x 97" multi-stripe borders

Fabric D - Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (4) 2" x 10-1/2" sashing strips and (12) 2" cornerstone squares
Fussy cut (6) 7-5/8" squares with large motifs centered and (2) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces with small motifs centered

Fabric E - Cut (8) 2" strips, subcut (32) 2" x 10-1/2" sashing strips

Fabric F - Cut (11) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (24) 2" cornerstone squares

Fabric H - Cut (1) 5-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 5-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles] and (2) 5-1/2" squares
Cut (4) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces and (14) 5-1/2" squares

Fabric I - Cut (1) 5-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 5-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles
Cut (4) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (28) 5-1/2" squares

Fabrics J and L - From each fabric:
Cut (2) 5-7/8" strips, subcut (8) 5-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles

Fabric K - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 82-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 76-1/2" borders

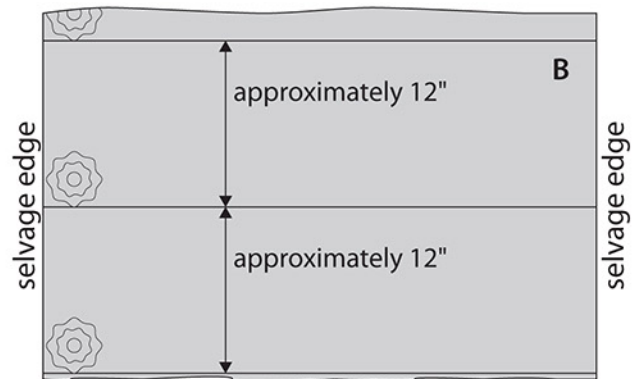
Fabric M - Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 103" and (2) 2-1/2" x 97" borders
Cut (8) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 79-1/2" borders, (2) 2" x 72-1/2" borders, and (5) 2" x 5-1/2" sashing strips
Cut (10) 2" strips, subcut (36) 2" x 10-1/2" and (7) 2" x 5-1/2" sashing strips

Fabric N - Cut (2) 5-7/8" strips, subcut (8) 5-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  *only as shown* for 16 triangles] and (4) 5-1/2" squares

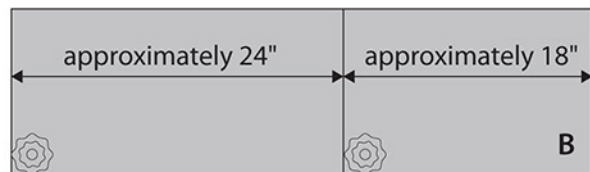
Stripes indicate orientation of directional print.

2. Piecing Order:

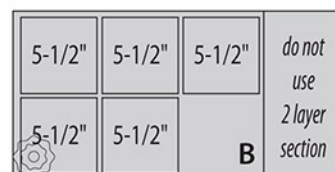
1. Trim one raw edge from **Fabric B** yardage. Measure along the selvage edge about 12" to the print repeat and cut strip. In the same manner, cut 1 more identical 12" strip.



2. On a 12" **Fabric B** strip, measure in about 24" to the repeat and cut into 2 sections, 1 about 12" x 24" and 1 about 12" x 18". Repeat on the second 12" **Fabric B** strip.

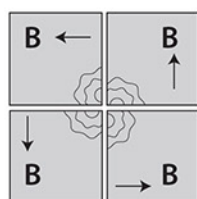


3. Stack the (4) 12" **Fabric B** strips right sides up on top of each other matching the design, with the 18" long strips on top. From the four layer section of stack, cut (5) 5-1/2" squares.



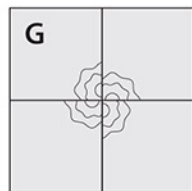
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4. Arrange four identical **Fabric B** squares from one stack as shown. Sew squares into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 5 **Block 1** (10-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 5

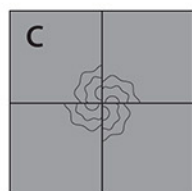
5. Repeat Steps 1-4 with **Fabric G** yardage to make 4 **Block 2**.

6. Repeat Step 1 to cut 4 identical 12" x width of fabric strips from **Fabric C** yardage.

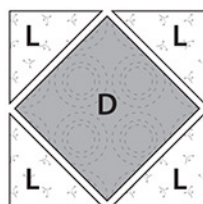
7. Stack the (4) 12" x width of fabric **Fabric C** strips right sides up on top of each other matching the design. From the four layer section of stack, cut (8) 5-1/2" squares.



Block 3 - Make 8

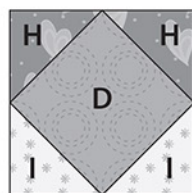
8. Repeat Step 4 to make 8 **Block 3** with stacks of **Fabric C** squares.

9. Sew 4 **Fabric L** 5-7/8" triangles to edges of a **Fabric D** 7-5/8" square. Make a total of

4 **Block 4** (10-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 **Block 5** with fabrics indicated.



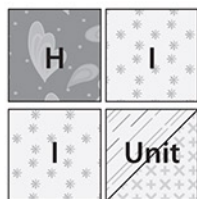
Block 5 - Make 2

10. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics J** and **N** 5-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 16 Units (5-1/2" square unfinished).

11. Arrange 1 **Fabric H** 5-1/2" square, 2 **Fabric I** 5-1/2" squares, and 1 Unit in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 12 **Block 6** (10-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 6 - Make 12

12. Stitch 1 **Fabric I** 5-1/2" square to a Unit as shown to make 2 each **Blocks 7a** and **7b** (5-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished).

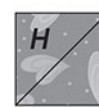

13. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all **Fabric N** 5-1/2" squares *only as shown*. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 4 **Fabric H** 5-1/2" squares.

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

14. Arrange a marked **Fabric N** square right sides together on a **Fabric H** 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Make a total of 2 **Block 8a** (5-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 **Block 8b** noting angle of seam.

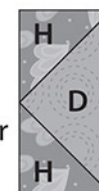

15. Using the same stitch-and-flip technique in Step 14, sew a marked **Fabric H** square on a **Fabric D** 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece to create a corner triangle. Repeat with a second square to add another triangle on the same long side of the **Fabric D** piece as shown. Make a total of 2 **Block 9** (5-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished).

16. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks, 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" **Fabric H** pieces, 2" x 5-1/2" sashing strips, 2" x 10-1/2" sashing strips, 2" sashing cornerstones, and borders.

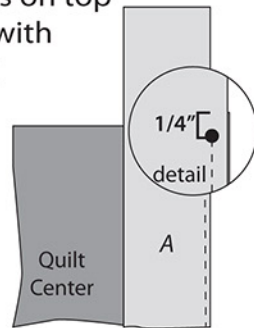
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17. Arrange all blocks, 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" **Fabric H** pieces, **Fabric M** 2" x 5-1/2" sashing strips, **Fabrics D, E**, and **M** 2" x 10-1/2" sashing strips, **Fabrics D** and **F** 2" sashing cornerstones in 13 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (69-1/2" x 79-1/2" unfinished).

18. Sew **Fabric M** 2" x 79-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric M** 2" x 72-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

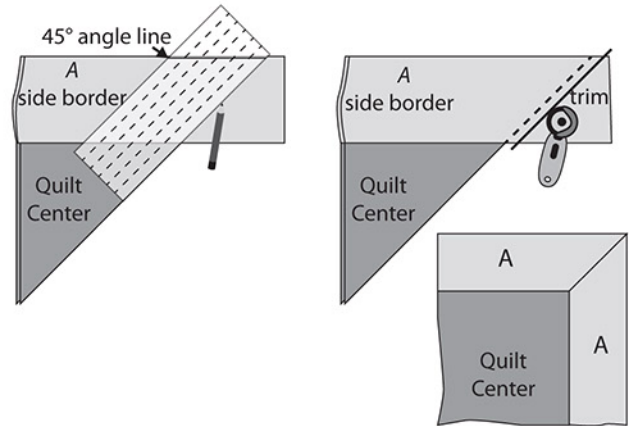
19. Sew **Fabric K** 2-1/2" x 82-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric K** 2-1/2" x 76-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

20. Center **Fabric A** 8-3/4" x 107" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric A** 8-3/4" x 97" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the wide stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

21. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



22. Sew **Fabric M** 2-1/2" x 103" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric M** 2-1/2" x 97" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

23. The quilt measures approximately 97" x 107" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric O**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

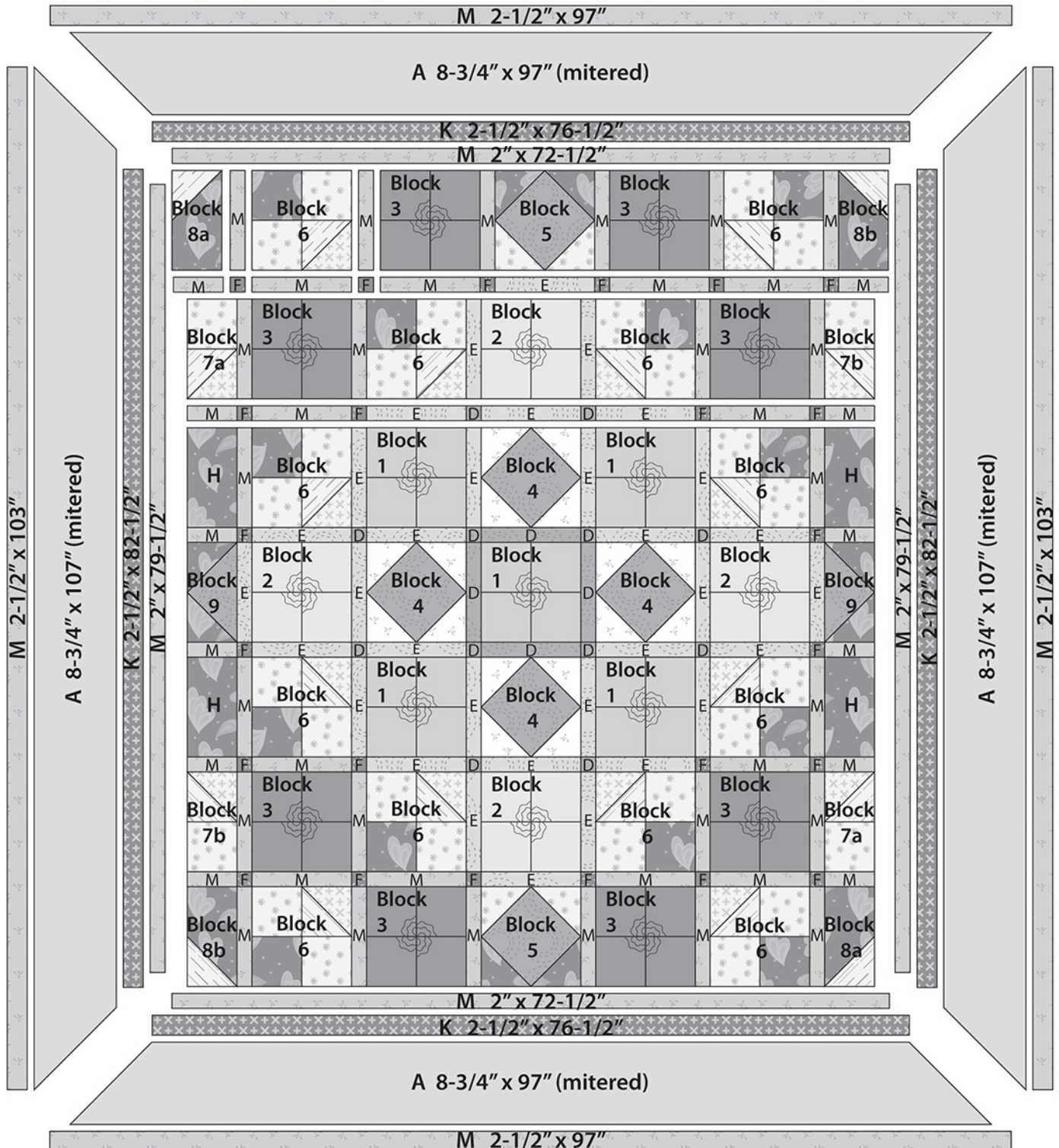
24. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric F**) and enjoy!!
