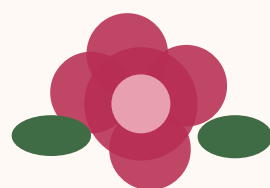


SUMMER ROSE AFGHAN PATTERN

Tunisian crochet and cross-stitch design



QUILTING WONDERS

Enjoy beautiful roses all year long with this stunning cross-stitch afghan.

Materials:

Lion Brand “Pound of Love” (Art 550)

#099 Antique White 3 skeins

Lion Brand “Wool Ease” (Art 620)

#104 Blush Heather 1 skein

#139 Dark Rose Heather 1 skein

#140 Rose Heather 1 skein

Lion Brand “Vanna’s Choice” (Art 860)

173 Dusty Green 1 skein

#174 Olive 1 skein

Afghan crochet hook size J (6 mm)

Crochet Hook size H (5 mm)

Large-eyed Blunt yarn needle

Sizes:

48 x 61 in. (122 x 155 cm)

Gauge: Working in Tunisian stitch;

17 sts and 15 rows = 4 in. (10 cm)

Be sure to check your gauge.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Sc2tog: insert hook into stitch indicated, yo, pull through st, insert hook into next st, yo, pull through st, (3 lps on hook), yo, pull through 3 lps on hook.

Picot: ch 3, sl st in top of last st made.

Puff St: work 2 dc in same sp or st indicated keeping the last lp of each st on hook, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

PATTERN NOTES:

1. Afghan is made by working four panels.
2. A border is worked onto each panel.
3. Design is worked by cross-stitching onto top front of panel.
4. A border is worked around the afghan.

AFGHAN

Afghan Panel (make four):

With Antique White and afghan hook, ch 38.

Row 1: Working from right to left in back bumps of each ch (horizontal bar in center of chain on wrong side of chain), insert hook in back bump of 2nd ch from hook, yo, draw through ch, * insert hook in back bump of next ch, yo, draw through ch *, rep from * to * across keeping all lps on hook (38 lps on hook), yo, draw through 1 lp on hook, ** yo, draw through 2 lps on hook **, rep from ** to ** across until 1 lp remains on hook.

Rows 2 – 202: Working from right to left, insert hook in 2nd vertical st from hook, yo, draw through st, * insert hook in next vertical st, yo, draw through st *, rep from * to * across keeping all lps on hook (38 lps on hook), yo, draw through 1 lp on hook, ** yo, draw through 2 lps on hook **, rep from ** to ** across until 1 lp remains on hook.

Row 203: Sl st in each vertical st across. Fasten off.

EMBROIDERY

With right side of panel facing and using cross-stitches follow Panel Chart A to cross-stitch design onto two panels. Follow Panel Chart B to cross-stitch design onto two rem panels.

NOTE: Make sure to count row-end st as a st when counting to start design.

NOTE: All Charts are at the end of the written instructions

PANEL BORDER

Rnd 1: With right side of panel facing, using size H hook, join Blush Heather in top right-hand corner,

ch 1, sc in first st, *[ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st] 18 times, ch 2 (corner made), working down length, sc in first row-end st, [ch 1, skip next row-end st, sc in next row-end st] down length to within last 3 rows, ch 1, skip next row, sc2tog over next 2 row-end sts, ch 2 (corner made) *, working across bottom of foundation ch, sc in first st, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: Join Rose Heather in top right-hand corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, *(sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-2 sp, [ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp] across to within 1 sc from next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, skip next sc *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: Join Antique White in top right-hand corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, ** (hdc, ch 2, hdc) in corner ch-2 sp, * skip next sc, work 2 dc in next sc 2 rnds below (Rnd 1) working sts in the sc and around the ch-1 sp above *, rep from * to * across to last sc before next corner ch-2 sp, skip last sc **, rep from ** to ** around, join with sl st to top of beg hdc. Fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

Follow Assembly diagram at the end of the written instructions to join Panels together.

ch-2 sp ,with size H hook and Antique White, matching sts and working through both panels, ch 1, sc in each ch of corner, working in front lp of st on top panel and back lp of matching st on bottom panel, sc in each st across to next corner ch-2 sp, sc in each ch of corner ch-2 sp. Fasten off, weave in ends.

Join rem Panels in same manner.

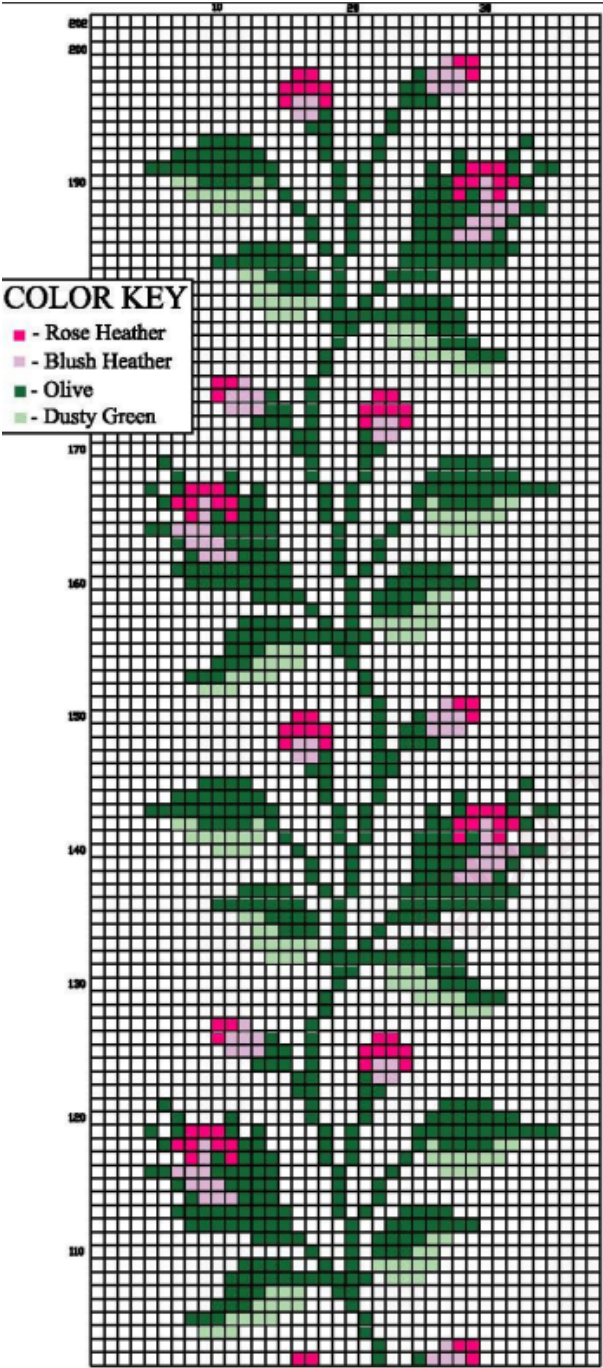
FINISHING

Afghan Border

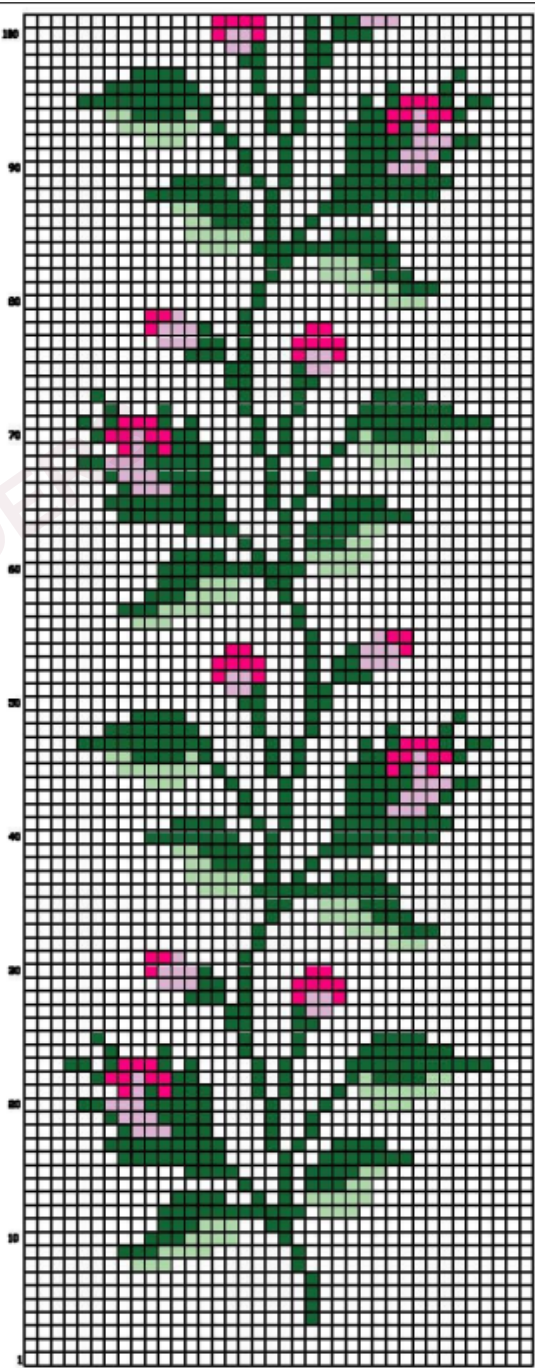
Rnd 1: With right side of afghan facing, and size H hook, join Antique White in top right-hand corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, *(sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-2 sp, [sc in each st across to joining seam, work hdc in ch-sp on each side

Rnd 2: Skip beg sc, sl st in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, * (sc, ch 1, sc, ch 1, sc) in corner ch-2 sp, [ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st] across to next corner ch-2 sp *, rep from * to * around, join with sl st to beg sc.

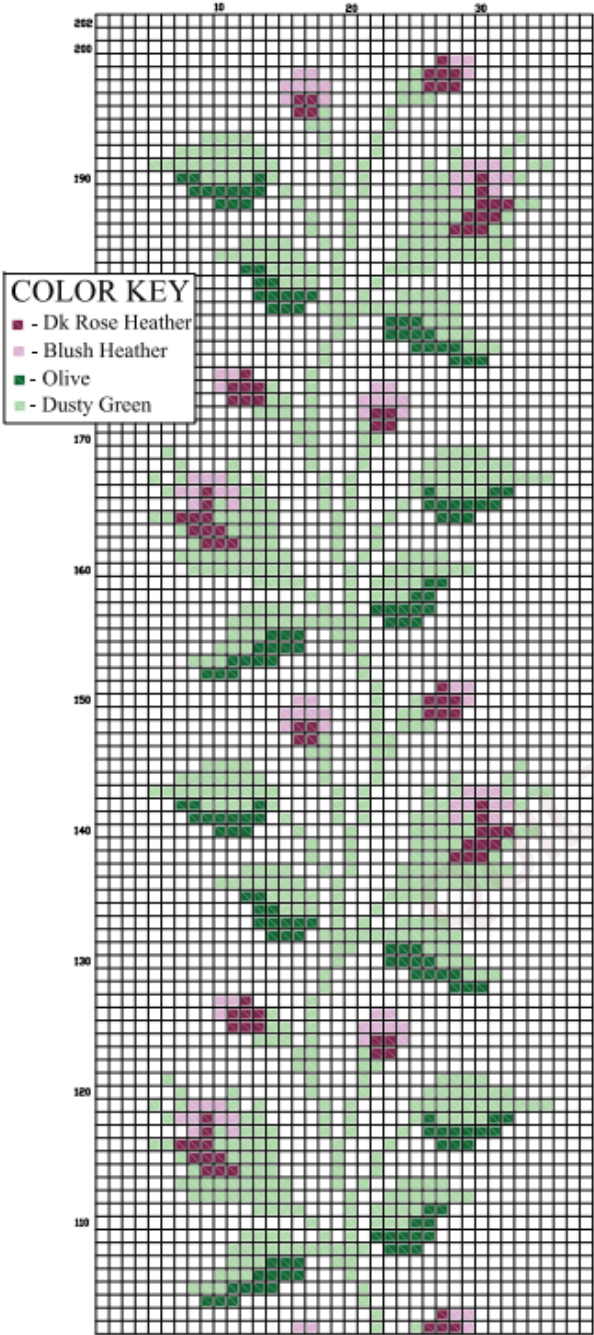
Rnd 3: NOTE: This rnd you will be working a (Puff st, picot) across the top and bottom of afghan and (2 dc, picot) down the each side of afghan. Skip beg sc, sl st in next ch-1 sp, ch 3 (first dc) (dc, picot) in same ch-1 sp, (2 dc, picot) in next ch-1 sp, * work (puff st, picot) in each ch-1 sp across to next corner, work (2 dc, picot) in each of the next 2 ch-1 sps of corner, working down length, work (2 dc, picot) in each ch-1 sp across to next corner *, work (2 dc, picot) in each of the next 2 ch-1 sps of corner, rep from * to * around, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3. Fasten off, weave in ends.



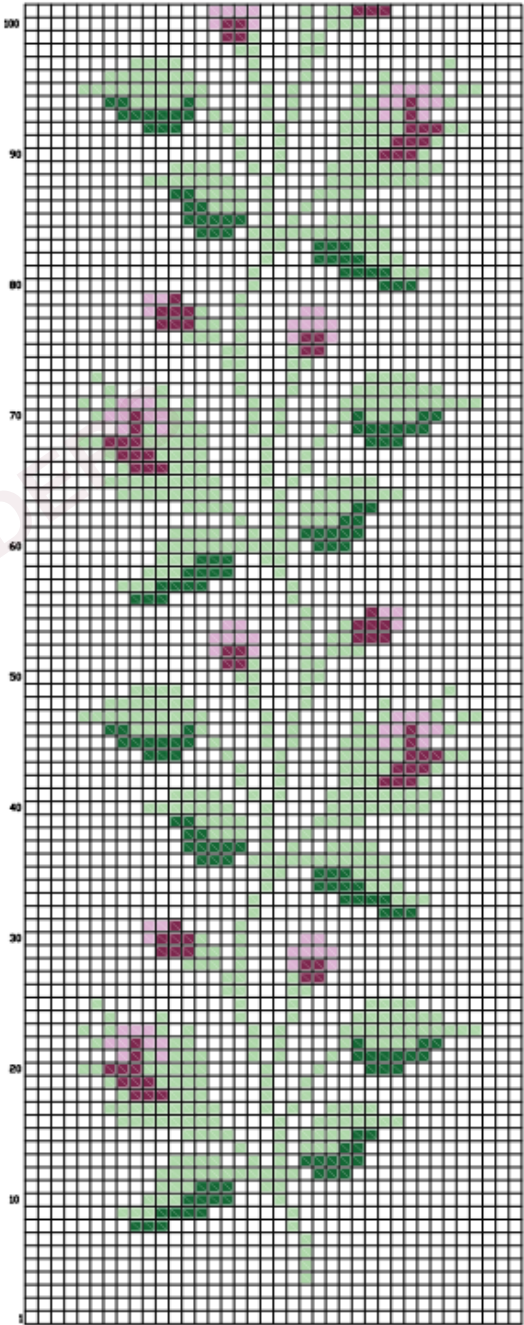
Summer Rose Afghan Chart A Top of Panel A



Summer Rose Afghan Chart A Bottom of Panel A



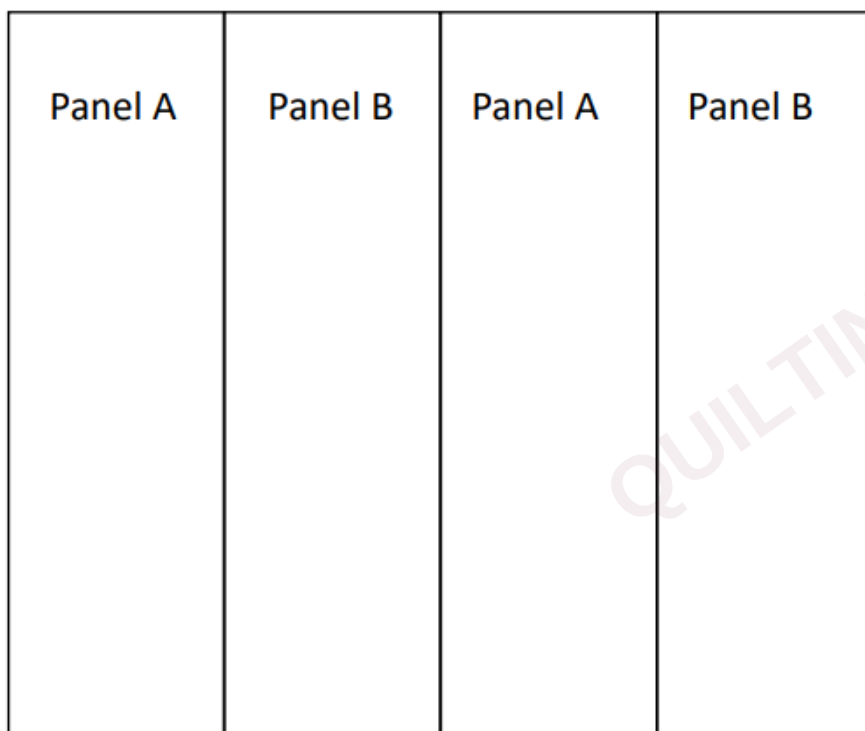
